



# PRAY *With Him*

A SIMPLE GUIDE TO WRITING SCRIPTURE-BASED PRAYERS



The Pray With Him prayers are designed to help you come honestly before God, speak His Word, and rest in His love.

*Prayer is a conversation with your Father. He is always near.*

## BEGIN WITH WHO GOD IS

Start by focusing on God's character instead of your fear or circumstance.

Ask: *Who is God in this moment?*  
What does Scripture say about His heart?

Examples:

- "Father, You are my refuge and strength."
- "Lord, You are near to the brokenhearted."
- "Jesus, You are my peace."

This shifts the heart from panic to trust.

## BRING YOUR NEED HONESTLY BEFORE HIM

God already knows what you are carrying. Speak honestly and openly.

Examples:

- "You see the anxiety I've been carrying."
- "I feel overwhelmed and tired."
- "I don't know what to do."

Prayer becomes relational when we stop hiding.

## PRAY GOD'S WORD BACK TO HIM

Use Scripture as the foundation of your prayer. This helps renew the mind, strengthen faith, and anchor emotions in truth.

Examples:

- "Your Word says You will never leave me."
- "You tell me to cast my cares upon You."
- "You promise to give wisdom generously."

God's Word is truth for your today.

## END IN TRUST AND SURRENDER

Close by placing the situation back into God's hands.

Examples:

- "I trust You with this."
- "Teach me to walk with You through this."
- "Help me rest in Your love."

Prayer is not only about answers. It is also about learning to remain with Him.

## THANKSGIVING OF FAITH

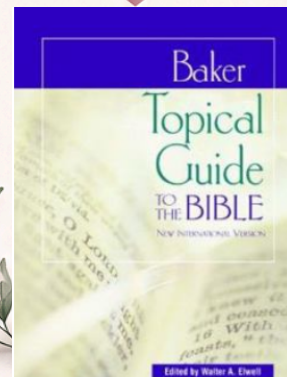
End by thanking God not only for what He will do, but for who He already is.

Examples:

- "Thank You for hearing me."
- "Thank You for being near to me."
- "Thank You that You are already working."
- "I praise You because You are faithful."

Thanksgiving shifts the heart from fear to faith and reminds us that God is faithful even before circumstances change.
